### 1 Minutes of Last Meeting

1.1 The Secretary presented the minutes of 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 18 January 2003. As no requests of amendment were received, the Chairman announced the acceptance of the same.

### 2 Official receipt of membership fee

- 2.1 The Chairman requested the Treasurer to check up as soon as possible whether there were members who returned their registration forms without paying up their membership subscriptions and, if there were, send them reminders. The Treasurer was also reminded to issue all paid-up members official receipts to serve the purpose of both acknowledgment as well as records.
- 2.2 Members opined that, instead of an official receipt, each of the paid-up members could be issued a member card. After deliberation, they all accepted the idea and the Chairman agreed to take up the design of membership card. At the same time Miss Daisy was requested to sort out those who failed to pay up their membership fees for the Treasurer to serve them with reminders.

### 3 "Helping the School Children in Mainland"

3.1 For members' reference, Ms Eastre provided the members with the information available from (i) 「護苗行動」organized by the Union College of CUHK and (ii) the "Nursery for Young Action Plan", both of which were voluntary agents running projects successfully to aid the needy school children in Mainland. As the 「護苗行動」was organizing a 3-day tour to visit one of their sponsored schools in Kwangtung, the Chairman said that he would like to join the said tour at his own cost, taking such

opportunity to study the feasibility and make recommendation to the TWTSAA for consideration. Ms Eastre promised to seek permission from the organization concerned.

(Post meeting note: The tour was fixed to set off on 18 March 2003 and a place for TWTSAA was reserved. Unfortunately, due to the outbreak of SARS the tour was postponed until further notice.)

3.2 Mr. Eddy Lee said that he had experienced a similar activity organized by his child's school. Seeing is believing, he was quite convinced that running projects of the same kind was meaningful and achievable.
