#### 1. Quorum and Chairman

It was noted that a quorum of members was present and the meeting was therefore duly convened and constituted. Mr Tang Wing Hong took the chair of the meeting.

# 2. Confirmation of the minutes of the last meeting

The minutes of the ninth meeting of the 7th ExCom held on 5 October 2015 were confirmed without amendment.

## 3. Matters arising from the last meeting

There was no outstanding matter arising from the last meeting to be followed.

#### 4. Treasurer's Report

Ms Yau Wai Ha, Iris reported that overall financial situation was healthy. The bank balance as of 7 December 2015 was HK\$62,968.91. The decrease in bank balance compared with last reporting was mainly derived from payment of various costs offset from subscription receipts.

## 5. Messages from TWTSAACF

## 5.1 Exploring new schools

Mr Chan Chit Wai, Stephen reported the following:

HMS had been servicing the schools at 懷集 and 籐州 for many years. Due to some personnel and policy changes at the schools, as well as the improvement of the general economic environment of the locations and students, it would be a time to seek new places to render our services. The possible new places would be 雲浮, 鬱南, 羅定.

HMS had initially planned to visit 雲浮鬱南小學, but due to tight time schedule, the visit had been cancelled.

HMS had formed a team of four persons visiting 河口镇中心小學 on 6 and 7 December 2015. They found the following:

The school has around 900 students of which around 200 students are boarding at school. The school had recently requested for financial assistance from the local Education Authority, to improve the buildings' construction but it was declined. HMS had found that the school buildings are overall at poor condition but not dangerous. Since the local authority had declined the school's request, therefore it would not be appropriate for HMS to step in and would not consider offering assistance at this point. Instead HMS might possibly consider purchasing bed racks for the boarding students. HMS would follow up in this matter.

# 5.2 Innovation Technology Programme

Mr Tang Wing Hong reported that the donation was presented to 全完第一小學. The principal would confirm the commencement date of the programme and thereafter report the progress to the Fundraising Committee. The Directors of the TWTSAACF were invited to visit the school.

# 6. Review of the Charity Variety Show

6.1 Mr Tang Wing Hong reported that more than 200 guests were shown up at the show.

The total donations for the show were HK\$336,224 and US\$1,000, of which including the sales proceeds of the non VIP admission tickets of HK\$14,900. Some production costs and expenses were sponsored by donors. After netting off the non – sponsored expenditures, the net proceeds were HK\$261,315.

6.2 It was found that quality of the DVD was not satisfactory. As the photo shooting and production of DVD were done by volunteer, offering complimentary services, we should not compare the quality standard with a professional company. Our production company Green Channel Productions Limited had previously proposed charge for these services; we declined and opted to use the service by our volunteer.

# 7.1 Publication 荃情
